

MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

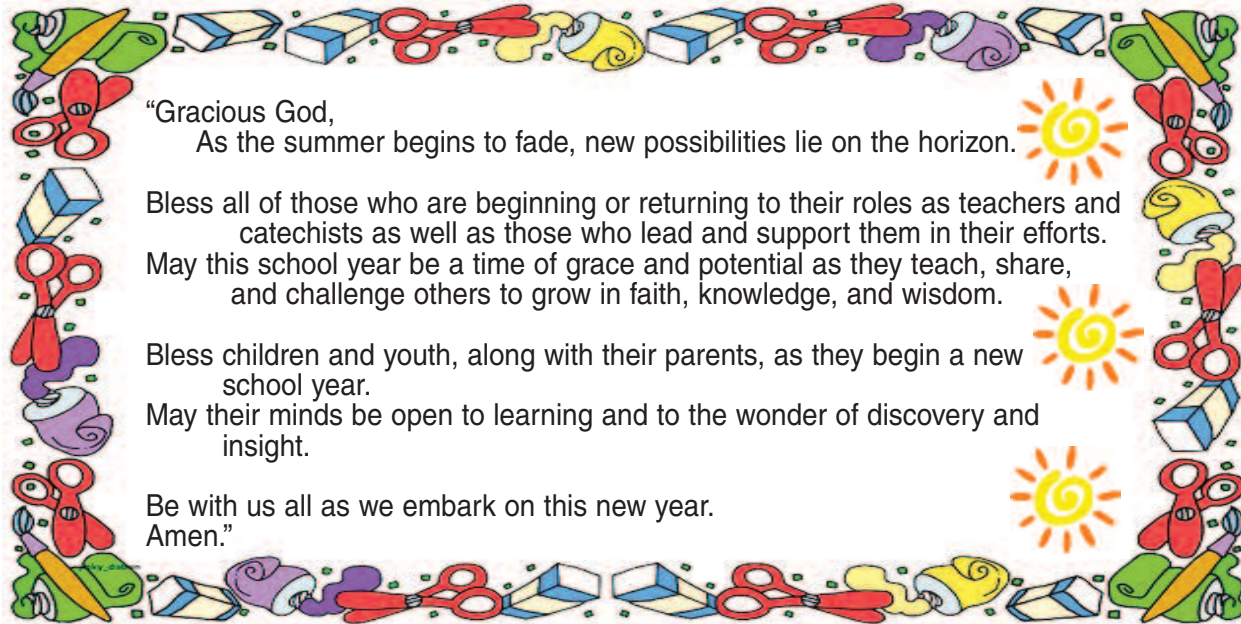
My dear Parishioners,

PILGRIMAGE FOR THE JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY

The Pilgrimage for the Jubilee Year of Mercy will be to visit the pilgrimage sites within the Diocese designated by Bishop Emeritus Michael Jarrell to reflect on the father’s Mercy and how we can emulate that mercy in our lives. It is scheduled for Tuesday, September 13, 2016 beginning with a 7am Mass at Sacred Heart of Jesus Church, 417 Saizan Ave., Port Barre. The bus will depart at 7:45am from the parking lot where the cars can be left. As a corporal Work of Mercy that day, please bring a donation of canned goods, personal care or cleaning supplies that can be delivered to New Life Center and Men’s Refuge. The expected arrival time back into Port Barre will be approximately 6:45pm. The price per person is \$70 which includes transportation, lunch, donation at each visit and snacks and individual bottles of water for the bus, and is contingent on 27 passengers before August 13th.
