PARISH COUNCIL MEETING ON OCTOBER 11, 2016 CONTINUED...**

7) Organizations-Charlie Dore – The KC’s monthly News Letter was reported by the President, Bruce Gaudin. On the weekend of the Tootsie Roll drive, the KC’s raised about \$2500. The Po-boy sale raised \$5600. \$5,000 of which would go to the steeple update.

The KC’S would be getting books, “Confessions of a Mega Church Pastor”, which will be handed out during Christmas.

K C Auxiliary is disbanded. Msgr. DeRouen suggested this because most K C wives are involved in other parish activities and are too pressed for time.

The Baby Bottle Right ToLife benefit would be on October 29.

Opelousas Catholic is having normal challenges. The enrollment is down. It is also down in the public schools. Possibly people are leaving the parish in general.

8) Elections: In November there was one position opening by Richard Lucito. A nominating committee was appointed with Keith Hebert, Joe Hidalgo and Jim Doherty to decide on the nominee to fill this position. The Committee will ask for nominations from congregation, then, the election will be held if more than one is nominated. The Committee will coordinate dates for that.

10) New Business:

Discussion: A discussion was held about 60-70% of graduated, college age students who discontinue church attendance. It was considered in learning something that they could do to bridge the year between high school and college to help these young adults continue attendance. There is a ULL group that travels and spreads the word in this regard. Msgr. DeRouen asked Keith Hebert to pursue this group speaking to these kids. Also, maybe there could be a speaker at the next CCD High School meeting.

Discussion: Online pornography is rampant in society. There are websites families can go to for help to reduce their children's exposure. Msgr. DeRouen states the State Police have a presentation about this. Keith Hebert will get information on this.

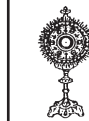
