MINUTES OF OUR LADY QUEEN OF ANGELS CATHOLIC CHURCH PARISH **COUNCIL MEETING ON JANUARY 24, 2017**

Attending were: Msgr. Keith DeRouen, Bruce Gaudin, Bill Pollingue, Jerome Collins, Jim Doherty, Paula Carriere, Keith Hebert, Richard Lucito, Elise Fontenot, and Joe Hidalgo.

Absent were: Richard Hollier, Charles Going, Charles Dore, Marie Leblanc and Wayne Reed.

The opening prayer was led by Msgr. DeRouen followed by roll call by Elise Fontenot. The meeting was called to order at 6:00p.m. There was a motion to approve the minutes by Joe Hidalgo and seconded by Paula Carriere. It was approved with all in favor.

- A. Discussion of election results followed: Richard Lucito was nominated and appointed to the Council, unopposed for another term. Charles Dore was nominated by Keith Hebert and it was seconded by Richard Lucito to Chair Organizations was appointed also unopposed to VP of Council for another term. Elise Fontenot was nominated by Joe Hidalgo and seconded by Richard Lucito was appointed unopposed as Secretary for another term.
- **B.** Committee Reports:
 - a)Regarding Religious Education-Jerome Collins reported that all programs have been well attended since Christmas. CCD attendance is averaged at 140.
 - b)Liturgy-Bill Polingue was pleased to announce that we have several new altar servers. The 5:15pm Mass still needs Eucharistic ministers and altar servers.
 - c)Finance-Charles Going stated that the Finance meeting was tomorrow. Msgr. DeRouen reports collections for Christmas and New Year exceeded expectations. The last financial report indicates our financial position after 3 months ending 9/30/16 shows total cash of \$818,535. Total revenues are up vs. 9/30/15 by \$113,591, mostly due to receiving an installment from the Centennial Campaign. Expenses are down \$23,520 due to reduced assessment by the Diocese (because of august flood), reduced supply cost and reduced advertising/public relations expenses. Our repairs and maintenance expenses are also less than the 3 months ending 9/30/15.
 - d)Evangelization-Paula Carriere: RCIA continues with Richard and Judi Lucito as Directors/Catechists. Three (3) people are enrolled in the program for receiving the Sacraments. Bulletin inserts will continue. Upcoming Events are The Epiphany and 100 Year Anniversary of Fatima Apparitions (presentation at Mass late April), Lenten Soup, Salad and Sermon sessions to be held: 3/15, 3/22 and 3/29 at 6:00pm and, early Fall presentation on Fatima apparitions and the Blessed Mother assigned special Rosary days on the 13th of each month from May through October.
 - e)Spirituality and Social Justice- Keith Hebert reported the 10/25/16 Mass celebrated by Msgr. DeRouen and Bishop Deshotel at Stevie Dupuis' house marked the 10th Anniversary of the Men's Mass Group. There were 105 attendees. The 11/15/16 Mass was celebrated by F. Nunez and Fr. Leger at Guaranty Glass warehouse. There were 70 attendees. The 12/06/16 Mass was celebrated by Msgr. Melancon at Our Lady Queen of Angels Church Hall. The OCS football team and coaches were invited. On 01/10/17 Andrew Guidroz invited all to attend the Men's Spring Retreat set for 3/2-5 at Our Lady of the Oaks Retreat House in Grand Coteau. February Mass will be the annual Couple's Mass to be held in the Church Hall, date to be announced.
