My dear Parishioners,

The Sunday before Thanksgiving, our Parish Altar Society worked hard planning, setting up and preparing food for our Parish Thanksgiving Luncheon. We prepared for 200; sadly, we didn't even have 75 people. For those 75 it was a good gathering, but so much food was left over. While we tried to make sure no food was thrown away, 125 portions of extra food are hard to use as left overs. The same thing happened last December when invitations were sent to all our volunteers inviting them to an appreciation Sunday afternoon coffee and desserts. We catered for 225 only to have well less than 100 attend.

I know people are busy and I so appreciate the volunteerism that sustains all our ministries in the Parish. But since these appreciation parties are so poorly attended, I find myself between a rock and a hard place. I do want people to know how the Parish appreciates the volunteer's sacrifice of time, talent, and resources. But spending \$400.00 on 4 large aluminum foil pans of turkey and having only 1½ of those pans eaten, the question comes – is this a waste? Not only the money, but are these gatherings worth the amount of time our Altar Society and Senior Angels spend preparing and cleaning afterwards.

After speaking with the leadership of these groups, we will forego these "extra" gatherings for the time being. We will have our Lenten "Soup, Salad and Sermon", our monthly coffee and donuts, and our Family Fun Day meal, but for now we will cease having our Thanksgiving Luncheon and December Volunteer Appreciation Gathering. May God continue to inspire our volunteers to give of their precious time, talent, and resources. May God inspire more volunteers to come forward. Again, the cancelling of these two events is not a sign of a lack of deep appreciation, just a move to try to be better stewards of people's time, talent and treasure.

Please remember the Mission begins this Sunday. The theme is "The Eucharist".
