

MINUTES OF OUR LADY QUEEN OF ANGELS CATHOLIC CHURCH PARISH
COUNCIL MEETING ON APRIL 5, 2016

The opening prayers was led by Msgr. DeRouen, followed by the roll call by the President, Bruce Gaudin and the meeting was called to order at 6:03 p.m. An approval of minutes was made by motion of Joe Hidalgo with all in favor.

Committee reports are as follows:

1) Religious Education – Deacon Jerome Collins -CCD ended March 21 and 22, 2016.
Forty five children received First Communion on Sunday, April 3, 2016 at 1:00 p.m. The homily was well received. Fifty children received Confirmation on Sunday, April 10, 2016 at 1:00 p.m. with Bishop Jarrell presiding.

2) Liturgy – Deacon Bill Pollingue - There was no Baptism preparation during Lent, but will begin again this Thursday as several couples are scheduled. There is a small turnover of Eucharistic Ministers as some are moving and others are not able to serve because of health issues. We are actively recruiting new ministers and receiving a favorable response from people being asked to serve. However, there is a need for both boys and girls as Altar Servers. We will lose several of them at the end of this school year and we will post the message in the Bulletin. It is expected the need will be filled within the next two months.

3) Finance – Charles Going – There were no outstanding issues at the recent finance meeting. Extensive repairs were made to the Hall air conditioner at a cost of \$6,000. Now it is working well. The new commercial range, donated by Bobby Dupre, has been installed in the Hall. The old stove will be used outdoors.

4) Evangelization – Paula Carriere – The first “Soup, Salad and Sermon” series was very successful and the parishioners requested more of these gatherings with lengthier sermons. This Easter Vigil, three adults received the Sacrament of Initiation, two adults received the Sacraments of the Holy Eucharist and Confirmation and five Catholics received the Sacrament of Confirmation. Five sponsors attended the RCIA sessions. The next RCIA cycle begins September 7, 2016 (a schedule is attached to the report) and culminates with the Easter Vigil on April 15, 2017. Richard Lucito gave thanks to Paula Carriere for a job well done. There was a discussion of the possibility of testimonials given at Mass by non-Catholics who attend Mass frequently. 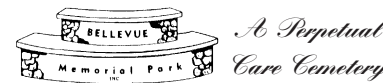
