7) Organizations - Charlie Dore – Knights of Columbus are continuing monthly Rosary meetings and helped with food preparation for one “Soup, Salad and Sermon” dinner and also for Family Fun Day. The Right to Life group has had no recent activities or immediate future plans. The Junior High Youth Group had no report. For the Married Couples Family Fun Day was well attended and successful. No other activities are planned at this time and the Children’s Liturgy continues. Youth Group report by Ann Speyrer revealed that the group attended the Way of the Cross on Good Friday and some will attend a Volunteers’ luncheon at the nursing home. The group is also making plans for their largest fund raiser, the Mother’s Day bake sale.

Vickie Reed with the Altar Society reports that the cards and medals that are distributed to all mothers at Mother’s Day Masses have been ordered and plans are being made for the Society breakfast for members and their spouses to be held on May 15.

Regarding Old Business, Msgr. DeRouen confirmed that more parking lot repairs are needed and a dangerous tree is being removed from behind the Rectory by Deacon Boudreaux, but no stump grinding is necessary. Joe Hidalgo addressed the need for parking lot exit signage. He and Richard Lucito will check into various solutions.

Under New Business, Paula Carriere states that many parishioners ask about a Church tour as done for the RCIA members. A suggestion was made that members possibly could go along with RCIA or Our Lady Queen of Angels could offer scheduled tours. Monsignor DeRouen stated that it would be of interest on the tour to explain the theological meaning of the Church windows. Trustee, Judge James Doherty will call the Diocese for this information and recommended checking archived bulletins from when the Church first opened. Date of the next meeting will be July 19, 2016 at 6:00 pm.

Meeting was adjourned at 6:38 pm. The closing prayer was led by Msgr. DeRouen.
