THE RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)

The time of year for preparing those who desire to become Catholic is upon us. RCIA is a process-oriented program of instruction, prayer, and ritual celebrations for persons interested in joining the Catholic Church. The process is concerned with the development of the person believing with the Church community through doctrinal formation, praying with the Church community through liturgical formation, and serving with the Church community through liturgical formation, and serving with the Church community through apostolic formation. The process prepares persons for the sacraments of initiation, which are Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist, all received at the Easter Vigil Celebration.

The RCIA Program begins September 7, 2016 and culminates at Easter Vigil, April 15, 2017. Sessions are typically held on two Wednesday evenings of each month, from 5:30-7:00 pm, in the Conference Room, in Our Lady Queen of Angels Church office.

As parishioners, we are all encouraged to invite non-Catholic friends, who may have expressed an interest in joining the Catholic Church, to come by the Church office to register.

Next Sunday, Paula Carriere, RCIA Director, will speak at all the Masses introducing the program.

EUCCHARISTIC PROCESSION ALONG BAYOU TECHE

The Eucharistic Procession along Bayou Teche will be on Monday, August 15th (Feast of the Assumption) in honor of the Arrival of the Acadians. It begins with Holy Mass and Homily by Bishop J. Douglas Deshotel, D.D., Bishop of Lafayette, at St. Leo's in Leonville at 8:00am. The procession to the landing at 9:00am and boat procession departs at 9:30am. The stops are at each Church on the Bayou: Arnaudville, Cecilia, Breaux, and Parks for Rosary and Benediction. It will end up in the evening at Evangeline Oak in St. Martinville. Then disembark and process into St. Martin de Tours for Benediction; then process down Main Street to Our Lady of Sorrows Chapel for Vespers and Benediction.
